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MARLBOROUGH SAUVIGNON BLANC

Lonely Cow Sauvignon Blanc jumps from the glass with aromas of white peach and lime, the mouthwatering palate is a juicy mix of candied pineapple and tangerine flavors followed by a crisp but lingering finish of wet stone and white pepper accents. This is what New Zealand is all about, as the label suggests Lonely Cow Sauvignon Blanc stands alone in its field.

NELSON PINOT NOIR

From the first sip the grace of this wine hits the palate and the fruit flavors linger in the mouth long after the last drop. The cool growing environment in Nelson produces an elegant and balanced style of Pinot Noir, perfect for food pairing or enjoyed on its own. This pinot displays enticing aromas of cranberry, black cherry and dried strawberries, combined with nuances of orange peel with a subtle hint of campfire smoke.

"Ah! Make a right at the lone Nikau just up the road" Patti responded.

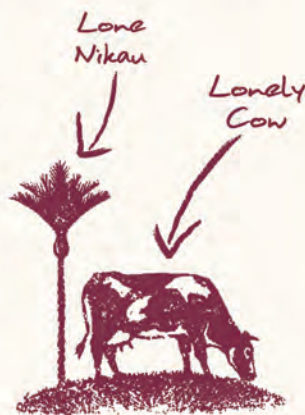
